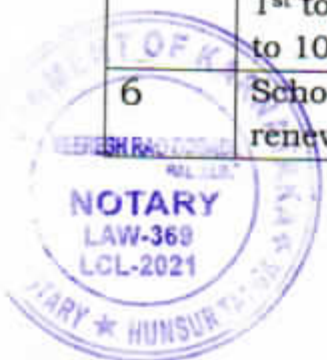

Bore, Hunsur Town, Mysore District, Karnataka (Address), application applied through ONLINE for renewal of first recognition from 1st to 8th Standard English Medium (Renewal Recognition/School First Recognition/Recognition Renewal), the school recognition has been renewed with due verification and spot inspection by the Departmental officers, from 01 June, 2022 to 31 May, 2027, subject to the following conditions:

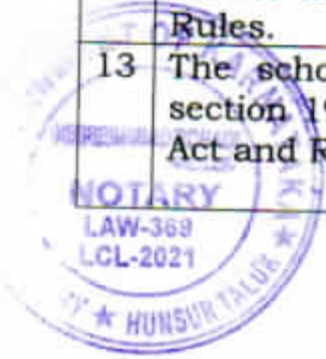


Conditions:

1	The school has been registered and the recognition has also been renewed under the Children Right to Education Act, 2009 and Karnataka Education Act, 1983 and the ruled made hereunder. (Primary education / higher education) 1 st to 5 th (1 st to 8 th , 6 th to 8 th , 9 th and 10 th and 1 st to 10 th), excepting these classes, no permission has been granted for additional classes and sections.
2	The school shall work as per Karnataka Education Act, 1983 and Children Right to Education Act, 2009 and the rules made there under.
3	25% seats shall be reserved for economically weaker section children as per Children Rights to Education Act, 2009 and the rules made thereunder. The schools under the RTE, the seats reserved by the government may be admitted under RTE. (so as to facilitate the parents of the children, the Government formed the rules and if there is any aided government schools in nearby places, children will be admitted to such schools). Otherwise, the private schools shall admit the children and allow them to continue until they reach primary stage, without any disparity.
4	As explained the para-3, the government will release the fee amount for school fees of the children who admitted through RTE. Therefore, it has been strictly prohibited from collecting any fees from these children.
5	It has been strictly prohibited the receipt of any kind of capitation fee, voluntary donations from the parents while admitting the children or thereafter.
6	It is must to publish the information in the school notice board as well as in the school Website, about the education fees collected by the school / managing committee, as per the State Government Official Memorandum No.ED 31 PGC 2019, dated 27-07-2019. No excess fee shall be collected other than the prescribed fee.
7	The school / managing committee shall admit the children within the time prescribed by the Government.
8	The school / managing committee shall not reject the admission for the following reasons:
	i] Due to non availability of age proof certificate
	ii] On the basis of the caste, religion, birth place and language.
	iii] If requested for admission after the date of extension for admission.



9	Should follow all precautionary measures as per the RTE Act and Rules and as per Karnataka Education Act and rules made there under. (Fire Extinguisher and stability certificate of the building by the concerned authorities and K.S.C.P.C.R. and N.C.P.C.R. about the children safety).
10	The school / managing committee shall not ;
	i] oust out from the school or continue in the same class until the child complete his primary and middle education.
	ii] give torture to any child either mentally or physically.
	iii] No children is required to succeed in any of the Board examinations until he complete his primary education.
	iv] Certificate will be issued to each child as prescribed under RTE Rules-21 and Karnataka Education Act and Rules made thereunder.
	v] The children who requires special attention / care shall also be admitted as per RTE Act and Rules and Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
	vi] The teachers appointed shall have minimum qualification as prescribed for Primary and High School Teachers as per RTE Act and Rules and as per Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
	vii] The salaries and allowances payable to the Teachers and Rules and conditions are as per the State Government Guidelines. And the salaries will be paid to the teachers as per the Government Official Memorandum (P.F.) through Bank and through other salaries to the teachers and will be adopted to ESI (Employees State Insurance).
	viii] The teachers shall carry out their duty as per Section 24(1) and as per RTE Act and Rules and as per Rule 17 of the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and they will not involve themselves in private tuitions for supervision.
11	The school shall follow the syllabus and text books as prescribed by the Education Authority.
12	The students shall be admitted according the facilities available in the school as per under section 19 of the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
13	The school shall follow the rules and regulations prescribed under section 19 and staff shall be appointed as per the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.



14	No branches or sections are allowed to open in the school premises or outside the school unauthorisedly.
15	The school building and the basic amenities shall not be utilized for any commercial activities or political and non educational activities either during day or night time.
16	The school shall not run for any particular person or group or profit motive.
17	The school shall be audited by the chartered accountant every year and submit the same on or before the end of June every year to the Deputy Director / Block Education Officer.
18	The school shall follow language rules (Kannada Language Rules, 2016) as per the Government Memorandum.
19	The managing committee and the teachers shall carryout their works as per RTE Act and Karnataka Education act and Rules.
20	The school / managing committee shall follow the rules and directions of the government and department strictly.
21	It is compulsory to update the school information every year by the end of March under S.A.T.S.
22	If any of the above conditions violated, the school recognition will be cancelled as per RTE Act, 2009 and Karnataka Education Act, 1983 and the rules made there under.
